

SVHL Playoff Format – Thursday Summer

Vitale Division

Semi Finals – August 13/26 – single game match

1st Place versus 3rd Place from the Regular Season.
2nd Place vs 4th Place from the Regular Season

Finals – August 20/26 – single game match

Championship: Winners from the Semi Finals.
Consolation: Losers from the Semi Finals

Franco Canadian Division

Round One – August 6/26 – Single Game Series

Elimination: 1st place (reg season) gets a bye.
2nd place plays 5th place
3rd place plays 4th place - Two winners advance to Semi Finals.

Round Two – August 13/26 – Single Game Series

Semi Finals: 1st place plays Wildcard (loser of Round One with the most points for).
Winners of Round One play a Semi Final

Final Round - August 20/26 – Single Game Series

Finals: **Championship:** Winners from Round Two play a final game.
Consolation: Loser from Round 1 plays Loser from Round 2 with most points for.

Roma & Kool Stuff Divisions

Round One – August 6/26 – single game series

Wild Card Series: First Place (regular season) vs Sixth Place game 1
Second Place (regular season) vs. Fifth Place game 2
Third Place (regular season) vs. Fourth Place game 3

Round Two – August 13/26 - single game series

Semi Finals: Winner of game 1 vs. the loser from round one with the most points for.
Winner of game 2 vs. Winner of game3
Consolation Semi: The other two losing teams battle for a consolation spot. game A

Round Three – August 20/26 - single game series

Championship: Winners of the Semi Finals from Round Two
Consolation: Winner of game A (round 2) vs. the loser from round 2 with the most points for
Bronze: The two other losing teams from round two play a Bronze game.

A & G Road Division

Round One – August 6/26 – single game series

Elimination: 1st place (reg season) gets a bye.
2nd place plays 7th place
3rd place plays 6th place
4th place plays 5th place

Round Two – August 13/26 – single game series

Semi Finals: 1st place (reg season) plays Winner of round #1 with the least points).
Two other Winners of Round One play a Semi Final game
Loser from round 1 with most points gets a bye.
Two other Losers play a Bronze semi final game.

Final Round – August 20/26 – single game series

Finals: **Championship:** Winners from Round Two play a final game.
Consolation: Loser from Round Two semi play a consolation final.
Bronze: Loser from Round One plays the winner from Round Two Bronze semi final

All playoff rules listed in the SVHL Adult Hockey rules package will be enforced, with the following amendment:

Tie Break: Games that cannot tie will be decided by a 5-minute sudden death extra period.
If still tied; a 3-man shootout will happen.
This is a tie-breaker, not a game.
Penalties incurred in the game will carry over into overtime
